# Guarantee yourself a place in the Dental Hygiene Program at the University of New Haven through the Three Rivers Community College Dental Hygiene Transfer Compact.

The Three Rivers Community College (TRCC) Dental Hygiene Transfer Compact is designed to provide special opportunities for individuals who are seeking an Associate in Science or a Bachelor of Science Degree in Dental Hygiene from the University of New Haven (UNH).

The Transfer Compact is for Three Rivers' students who complete a Certificate or Associate in Science Degree in General Studies developed for a smooth transfer into UNH's Dental Hygiene Program.

Upon completing the Associate in Science in Dental Hygiene Degree from the University of New Haven, graduates will be eligible to take both the Dental Hygiene National Board Examination and the Northeast Regional Board Examination to apply for the Registered Dental Hygienist (RDH) License.

## What are the benefits of the Dental Hygiene Transfer Compact?

- Guaranteed admission into UNH's Dental Hygiene Program upon successful completion of the Pre-Dental Hygiene Transfer Compact with and earned Certificate or Associate Degree in General Studies.
- Individual academic advisement beginning in the first semester by both Three Rivers and UNH advisors to ensure maximum transfer of credits.
- Substantial savings in tuition and time while students complete the first stage of their education at Three Rivers.
- Opportunity for academic achievement in small classes and labs at Three Rivers.
- A smooth transition between schools.

## How do you get started?

1. Apply to Three Rivers for the Pre-Dental Hygiene Certificate or Associate in Science General Studies Degree. Application is online. [http://www.threerivers.edu/Div\\_StudentServices/admissions/HowtoApply.shtml](http://www.threerivers.edu/Div_StudentServices/admissions/HowtoApply.shtml)
2. Complete the required courses, as specified in this brochure, with a grade of C or higher.
3. Work with the Coordinator of the Dental Hygiene Transfer Program at Three Rivers Community College to submit your application packet to UNH early during your last spring semester at TRCC.

## What are the conditions for final acceptance to UNH?

Complete the Pre-Dental Hygiene Certificate or Associate in Science Degree in General Studies Dental Hygiene Transfer compact at TRCC. All science courses must be taken within five years of enrollment at UNH. Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher, with a minimum grade of C or higher in all courses.
