For most new babysitters, building a babysitting business starts with family, friends, and then neighbors. Upon successful completion of the course, including a first aid skills demonstration and a CPR and AED skills test, student receive a Heartsaver First Aid CPR AED course completion card, valid for two (2) years.

**AHA BLS (Basic Life Support)**

Instructor: CPR Alive

The AHA's new BLS has been updated to include science and education from the 2015 Guidelines Update for CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) and ECC (Emergency Cardiovascular Care). This four-hour course teaches both single-rescuer and team basic support skills for application in both prehospital and in-facility environments, with a focus on high-quality CPR and team dynamics. In this instructor-led course, students participate in simulated clinical scenarios and learning stations. Students work with an AHA BLS instructor to complete BLS skills practice and skills testing. Students will also complete a written exam. Students successfully completing this four-hour certification course will receive their Healthcare Provider certification e-card by email within 20 days and valid for 2 years.
