Instructions For Use:

- 1. Condition r oom and materials at 65°F for 48 hours prior to, during and after installation. Avoid hot and sunny conditions.
- 2. Sweep floor and r emove any dirt or debris prior to installation.
- Make sur e floor is free from grease, oil, paint, or other contaminant that might interfere with the bond of the adhesive.
- 4. Do not install on floors with high moistur e or alkali content.
- Spr ead adhesive with the correct trowel making sure to maintain trowel notchings throughout the installation.
- 6. Allow the adhesive to flash for 15 minutes prior to installing the flooring material.
- 7. Apply only as much adhesive that can be installed within 45 minutes.
- 8. Pr ess flooring firmly into adhesive.
- Roll in both dir ections according to floor manufac turers recommendations.
- 10. Clean wet adhesive and tools with white cloth and soap and water.

Caution:

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. If splashed in eyes, flush with copious amounts of water for 15 minutes and call physician. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Use with positive fresh air cross-ventilation. Do not take internally. If swallowed do not induce vomiting, call physician immediately. Keep container closed. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
