## SECTION VII - SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN CASE MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED

Eliminate all ignition sources. Ventilate area. Small spills should be flushed with large quantities of water. Large spills should be collected on absorbent media for disposal.

WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD

Incinerate liquid in furnace (where permitted). Do not incinerate container. Contact EPA for alternative methods.
