TEXTBOOK: Precalculus-Mathematics for Calculus 6e by Stewart, Redlin, Watson.

Course Description: This course prepares students for the study of Calculus 1. Covered topics will include the study of polynomials, rational, exponential, logarithmic, and trigonometric functions.

ATTENDANCE: Attendance will be taken during every class. You are expected to attend each class and to be in class on time. You are also responsible for any material covered in class, including homework assignments and scheduling of exams.

GRADING: Four announced 100 point tests will be given along with a final test worth 200 points.

You may retake a test at the end of a semester that you did the most poorly on. Make-up tests will be given in place of a retake at the end of the semester and only one make-up test will be allowed.

HOMEWORK: Homework will be assigned during each class and will be gone over on the following class. Homework should be kept in an organized notebook.
