**TEXTBOOK:** Precalculus-Mathematics for Calculus 6e by Stewart, Redlin, Watson.

**Course Description:** This course prepares students for the study of Calculus 1. Covered topics will include the study of polynomial, rational, exponential, logarithmic, and trigonometric functions.
