RE: Recording During Class

Recording during class may be done strictly for educational purposes. However, any distribution or broadcasting may only be done with the written permission of any and all visible and/or audible participants.

RE: Exchange and Negotiation of Coursework

Students may wish to negotiate with the instructor to use some of their work from other classes to fulfill the requirements for English 100. *This may only be done after meeting with the instructor and obtaining written permission.* Otherwise, students are expected to complete work as assigned.

RE: Children/Siblings in the Classroom

From time to time it may be necessary for students to bring their children or siblings along to class. Children are welcome as long as they are not sick, contagious, or overly disruptive. Please be sure to bring appropriate work for them.

RE: Food and Beverages

Food and beverages are allowed in classrooms, except in the computer lab and library. This privilege may be revoked if students do not clean up after themselves – and any irresponsible parties before them. Leave the classroom neater than it was when you entered.
