2. Lifelong Learners Parking Services Update	Joseph Victorino reported that the SGA denied the request for additional handicap parking spaces by the Lifelong Learners Group. The SGA recommended they pursue other options especially as we are already meeting state regulations. Ideas included implementing parking passes or utilizing a van at designated areas. Dean Goetchius will review these suggestions and report back to Cabinet at future meeting.	Steve Goetchius will review SGA suggestions and report back to Cabinet on feasibility.
3. Advancement / Foundation Update	Betty Baillargeon reported 1) on May 7 th , 188 students received 270 scholarship & awards totaling over \$410,000, 2) The Foundation received \$10,000 from the Community Foundation to support Allied Health Non-Credit Programs. The Community Foundation also awarded \$30,000 for Environmental Research, Fieldwork & Hands-On Learning Internship to be paid over 3 years (\$10,000 has been received). This internship will be coordinated by Diba Kahn-Bureau, 3) Dorothy Lewis, class of 1978, established a scholarship endowment in the amount of \$15,000.	
4. Congress Update	Nicola Ricker advised that at the recent meeting of the College Congress, a vote was taken by only full-time faculty and approved to initiate a vote of no confidence. Specific wording is "Resolved, that the Three Rivers Community College Faculty Senate, as the representative body for faculty of Community College, votes No Confidence in the "Students First" plan, Mark Ojakian, president of the CSCU system, and the Board of Regents for the CSCU system."
